Cancellations and Schedule Adjustments

Occasionally, offerings may have to be canceled. Times may also be adjusted after the publication has been printed due to scheduling changes. We apologize for any inconvenience this may cause. For the most up-to-date class times and information, please check the online registration page or call 713-662-7420. Each class must meet minimum registration requirements a week before the class begins, or it will be canceled. If a class is canceled, refunds will be processed or transfers will be given.

Refunds

Refunds will not be issued once a class begins, whether you have attended class or not. Attendance is the responsibility of the participant. However, transfers will be given to those who qualify. Withdrawals are allowed up to five business days (Monday – Friday) before the class begins and 10 business days for camps. If you decide to withdraw from a class before it begins, a \$10 administration fee per person, per class will be deducted. Please allow two to three weeks for processing of refunds.

3. To register online, a user name and password are necessary. **If you do not already have a user name and password, please allow 3–5 business days to receive this information once the account has been created.**
4. Choose your class and click to register.
5. Complete registration, pay with a credit card, and receive an instant email confirmation of your enrollment.

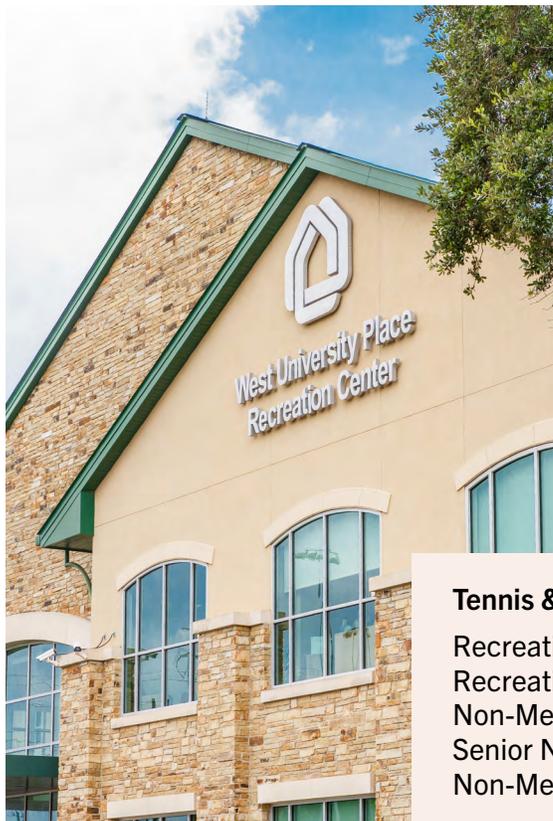

Parks and Open Space Master Plan

At the October 27, 2025, Council meeting, an update to the 2015 Parks and Open Space Master Plan was presented for Council's consideration. With input from the Parks and Recreation Board and City staff, this 2025 Parks and Open Space Master Plan Update focuses on the following updates:

- Updated demographics and survey information
- Updated park assessments/inventories and included park classifications
- Analyses and recommendations for lighting and shade in parks and greenspaces
- Identifying potential locations for pickleball courts and displays of public art
- Exploring connectivity to Braes Bayou and Memorial Park trails
- Ensuring safe railroad crossings at Bellaire Blvd. by the Recreation Center and safe pedestrian access to parks



This report should be considered a planning tool that can be used by current and future West U residents and leaders to make decisions regarding the wise use of monetary and physical resources and providing for outdoor parks and recreation facilities. Factors and conditions will change over time; staff and community leaders must remain in touch with the needs and wishes of West U residents. 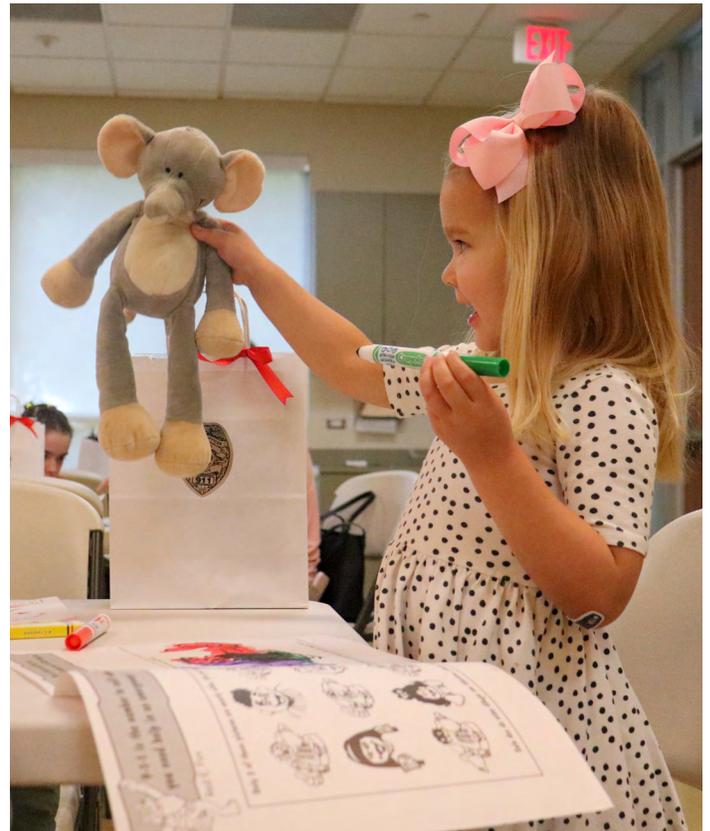

If, for any reason, a student needs to be moved, the instructor will notify the parent, and staff will try to move your child into the appropriate level class (space pending). Management reserves the right to add or subtract students, as needed, in order to increase the efficiency and effectiveness of the class.

Pool Policies & Regulations

- Unless otherwise noted, the Recreation Center pool and the Colonial Park pool are open to West U residents, members, and their guests.
- **The Recreation Center pool and the Colonial Park pool are only operational when lifeguards are on duty.**
- **Sharing Lanes:** During busy times, sharing lanes with other members is required. This ensures that everyone has the opportunity to enjoy the pool while classes and activities are taking place.
- Children must be accompanied by an adult in the water, and the adult must be actively swimming (within an arm’s length) of children at all times. Children who are 10 and older, and who are strong swimmers, may swim independently. Staff have the right to evaluate swim ability by conducting a swim test.
- To observe classes at the Recreation Center pool, please use the designated viewing areas.

Lap Lane Availability varies depending on the time of day, scheduled classes, and other activities taking place. To ensure that everyone has access to the pool, we provide the following information regarding lane availability:

- **Weekday Lap Lane Availability (Peak Hours Monday–Friday):**
4:00 – 7:45 PM (Peak Hours): Please be aware that, during these hours, lap lanes are in high demand due to scheduled classes. As a result, fewer lanes may be available for lap swimming.
- **Weekend Lap Lane Availability (Peak Hours Saturday & Sunday):**
8:00 AM – 1:00PM: Similar to weekdays, weekend lap lanes are more limited due to classes and other scheduled activities.

Seasonal rentals for 2026 will start on May 9.

Reservations can be made up to six months before your event.

Pool and Multi-Purpose Room Rental

Fee: \$250 R (per-hour rental rate), 2-hour minimum, includes up to 60 guests.

These rentals are during regular operating hours.

Exclusive Pool and Multi-Purpose Room Rentals

Fee: \$600 R (per-hour rental rate), 2-hour minimum, includes up to 250 guests, and pre-approval required by management.

Times: Saturdays, 7:30–9:30 pm

Sundays, 9:30–11:30 am, and 7:30–9:30 pm

Note: This rental does not include the concession/kitchen area.

Park open spaces are available on a first-come, first-served basis. Exceptions are spaces that can be reserved: Colonial Park Pavilion, Colonial Park Wooden Deck Off-Season (Case Side), and tennis court reservations. Inflatables are only allowed on the east end of Colonial Park with a pavilion reservation, and proof of insurance is required. Colonial Park Pool members receive a 10% discount on all pool rentals.

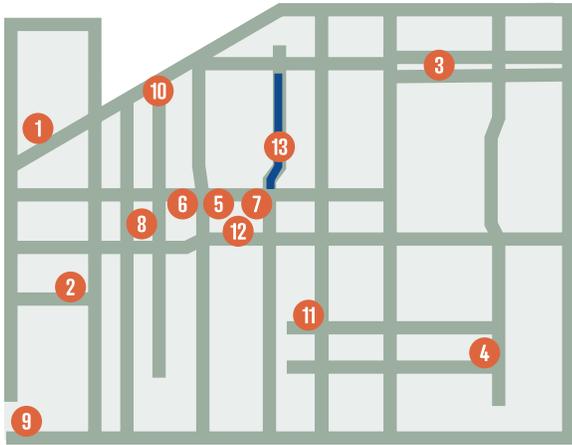
