COVID-19 Weekly Update – September 28, 2020

- Our Trauma Service Area region (TSA-Q) remains at 6.3%, this is the new metric that the Governor is using to drive re-opening decisions; regions below the 15% threshold were allowed to expand occupancy limits under the last executive order. This data is available through the Southeast Texas Regional Advisory Council (SETRAC).

- Positivity rates:
Texas: 6.15% as of yesterday which is down from 6.41% reported last week.
Texas Medical Center: 3.2% (as of September 23)
Harris County Public Health: 6.8% - 14 day average as of (September 20)
- As reported in the last Council update, there appears to be several months of backlogged data that was recently dumped from the Department of State Health Services(HCPH)these updated numbers indicate that WestU now has a total of 127 confirmed cases of COVID-19, 13 of these cases are “Active” and 114 have “Recovered”. Zero “Deaths” have been reported in WestU due to COVID-19. The Fire Chief is reaching out to Harris County Public Health to confirm the accuracy of this change in data. Monday’s report was 53 confirmed cases, 4 active, 49 recovered, 0 deaths.
