

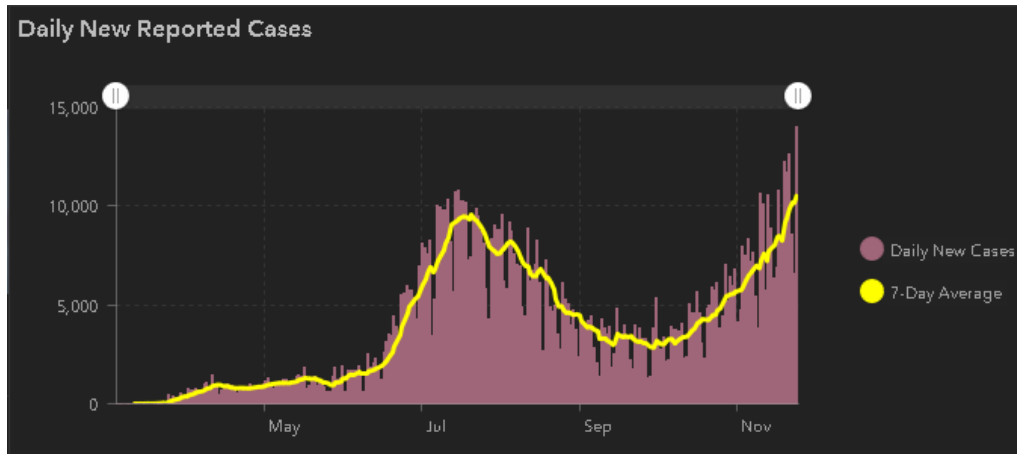

COVID-19 Local Weekly Update – November 25, 2020

- Staff is continuing to monitor the growth of the 3rd wave of COVID cases in Texas with daily new cases peaking near 14,000 per day which is significantly higher than the peak of the 2nd wave.



- The COVID Hospital Census for Trauma Service Area Q is up to 11.7% which is up from last week but still below the state's 15% threshold.

- Texas Medical Center ICU's are 92% full under phase 1 configurations.
- Positivity Rates:
 - Texas: 10.6% as of November 24, 2020
 - TMC: 5.9% as of November 25, 2020
 - HCPH: 9.5% as of November 17, 2020
- Harris County Public Health indicates West University Place to have 232 "Confirmed Cases", 47 "Active Cases", 185 "Recovered Cases" and Zero "Deaths".
