

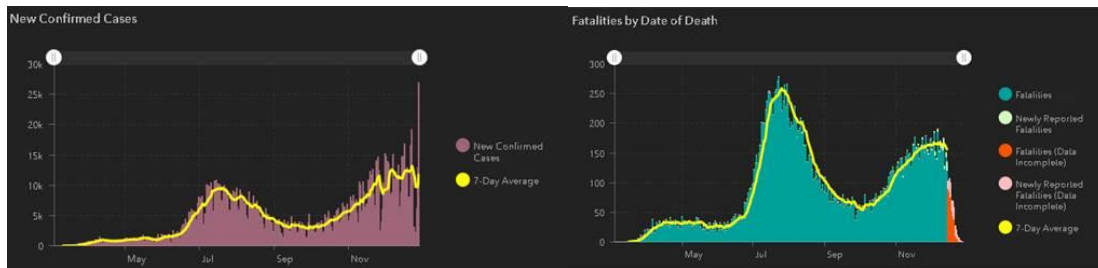

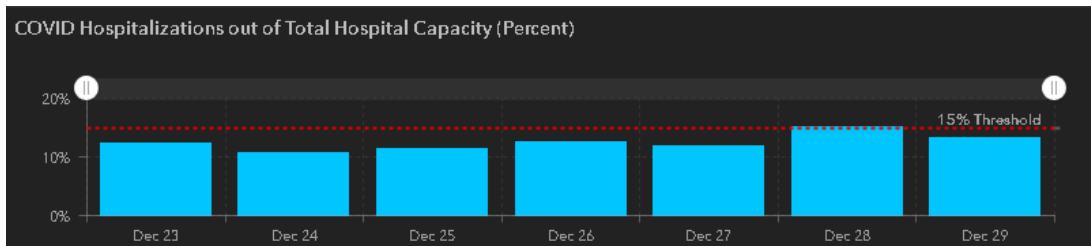

COVID-19 Local Weekly Update – December 30, 2020

- Roughly half of FD personnel have either received their 1st dose of vaccine or have been scheduled to receive it in the next few days. This has been done through a partnership with Memorial Hermann Hospital. As for the City’s vaccination program, the FD is still waiting to receive an allocation of vaccine from the State.
- In Texas, the growth phase of the third wave of COVID19 continues with a staggering record high number of 26,990 new cases recorded on 12/29/2020. This comes after a lull in identifying new cases through the Christmas holiday.



- COVID Hospitalizations out of Total Hospital Capacity for TSA Q is at 13.29% for 12/29/2020.



- Harris County Public Health data indicates West University to have 335 total “Confirmed Cases”, 63 “Active Cases”, 272 “Recovered Cases” and Zero “Deaths”.
- Positivity Rates: Texas- 17.15% , Harris County- 13.8%, TMC- 13.1%
- TMC is reporting the ICU’s to have exceeded Phase 1 configuration and are at 81% of the combined Phase 1 and Phase 2 capacities.
