COVID-19 Local Weekly Update – January 7, 2021

- In Texas, the growth phase of the third wave of COVID19 continues with 19,598 new cases confirmed on 01/07/2021.
- COVID Hospitalizations out of Total Hospital Capacity for TSA Q is at 18.72% as of 01/06/2021. TSA-Q, which includes Harris County, now has restrictions that limit restaurant occupancy to 50% and forces bars to close. These restrictions will be in place until the percentage falls back below the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.
- Harris County Public Health data indicates West University to have 395 total “Confirmed Cases”, 104 “Active Cases”, 291 “Recovered Cases” and Zero “Deaths”. These numbers have grown substantially since last week, as of last report West U had only 63 “Active Cases”.
- Positivity Rates: Texas- 20.68% , Harris County- 16.5%, TMC- 14.6%
- TMC is reporting the ICU’s to have exceeded Phase 1 configuration and are at 83% of the combined Phase 1 and Phase 2 capacities.
