

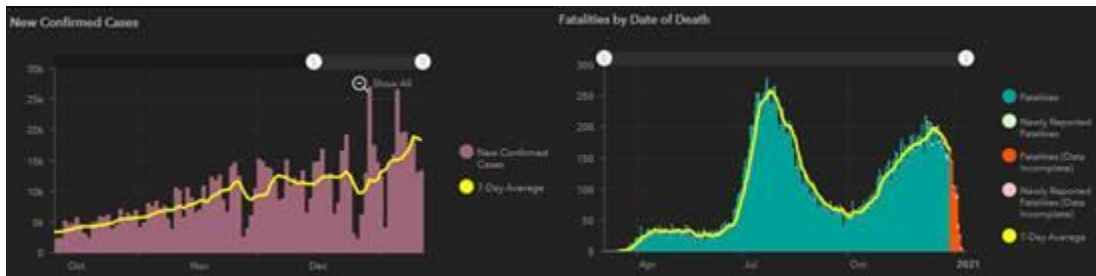

COVID-19 Local Weekly Update – January 12, 2021

- In Texas, the third wave of COVID19 continues with 18,900 new cases confirmed on 01/09/2021.



- COVID Hospitalizations out of Total Hospital Capacity for TSA Q is at 21.01% as of 01/10/2021. TSA-Q, which includes Harris County, now has restrictions that limit restaurant occupancy to 50% and forces bars to close. These restrictions will be in place until the percentage falls back below the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.



- Harris County Public Health data indicates West University to have 424 total “Confirmed Cases”, 123 “Active Cases”, 301 “Recovered Cases” and Zero “Deaths”. To put these numbers in perspective, as of 12/23/2020 West U had only 51 “Active Cases”.
- Positivity Rates: Texas- 18.71% , Harris County- 18.8%, TMC- 13.5%
- TMC is reporting the ICU’s to have exceeded Phase 1 configuration and are at 81% of the combined Phase 1 and Phase 2 capacities.
