

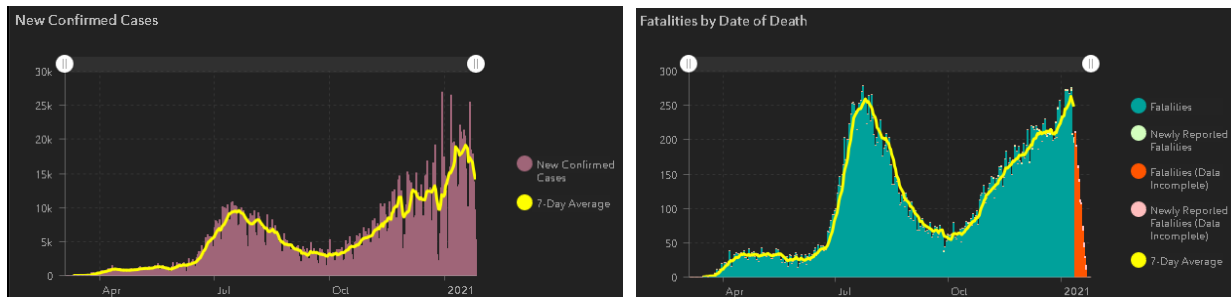

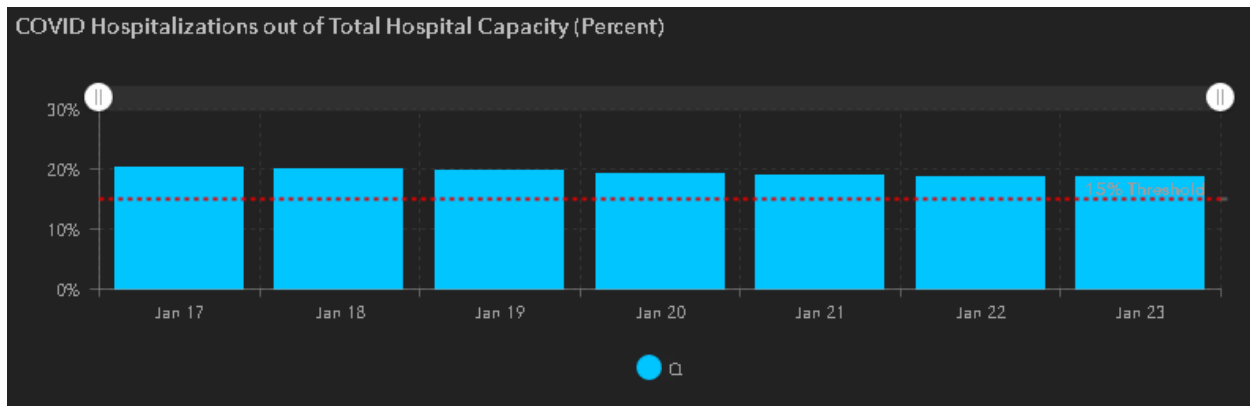

COVID-19 Council Update – January 25, 2021

- In Texas, after another near record number of cases reported last week, the state has seen fewer cases reported each day since with 13,700 new cases were reported on 01/24/2021 which may indicate a downward trend for the state.



- COVID Hospitalizations for TSA Q is at 18.58% as of 01/24/2021 which dropped more than 1% since last week. The enhanced restrictions for bars and restaurants will be in place until the percentage falls back below the 15% threshold for 7 consecutive days.



- Positivity Rates: Texas- 14.75% , Harris County- 19.0%, TMC- 11.6%
- TMC is reporting the ICU's to have exceeded Phase 1 configuration and are at 84% of the combined Phase 1 and Phase 2 capacities.
- Harris County Public Health data indicates West University to have 471 total "Confirmed Cases", 96 "Active Cases", 374 "Recovered Cases" and I regret to inform you that the data indicates that West U now has had 1 "Death" due to COVID-19.

- Vaccine Update: Harris County currently has 3 COVID Vaccination Hubs for Phase 1A and 1B. Most of the regions vaccine allocations are being delivered to these vaccine hubs.

Harris County Public Health will be launching a new waiting list for the COVID-19 vaccine which will allow any resident to sign up and those on the waiting list will be prioritized and randomized within the proper phase of vaccine rollout. Residents outside of current eligible phases can be placed on the wait list but would not be vaccinated until the proper vaccine phase has been reached.
