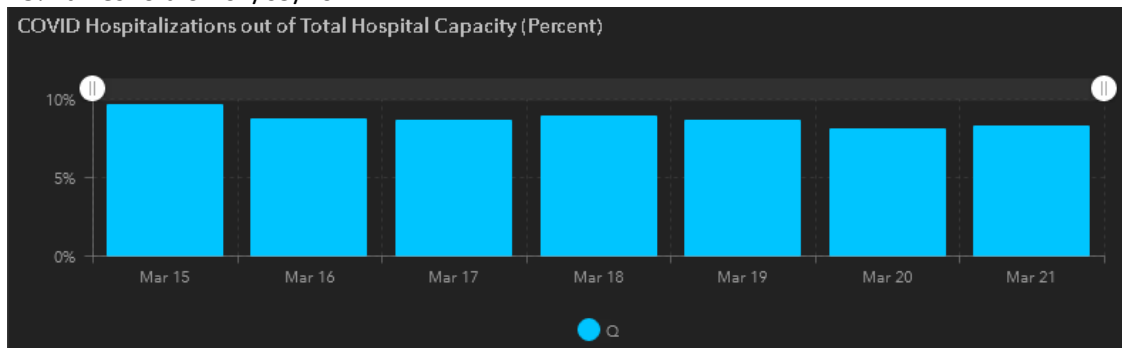


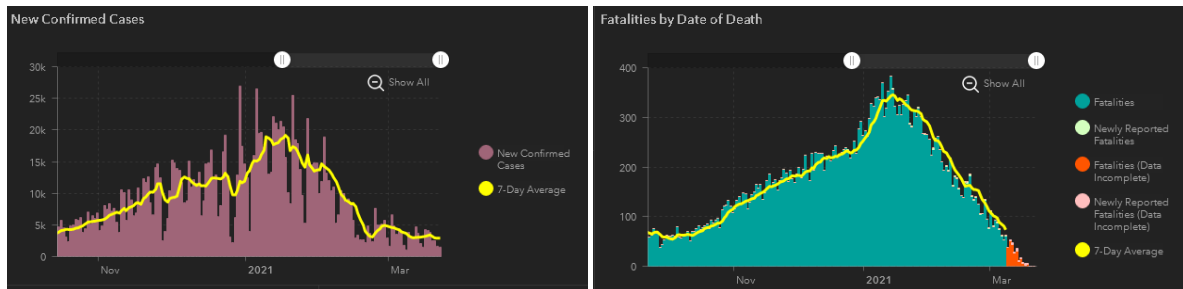


Council Update – March 22, 2021

- COVID Positivity rates, cases and hospitalization rates continue to drop. City staff is looking to bring back several senior programs in April that can be conducted while adhering to mask policy and providing for social distancing. Most of these events being considered to return are outdoor or drive-through type events.
- COVID Hospitalizations for TSA Q was 8.31% as of 03/08/2021. The rate last dropped below the 15% threshold on 02/09/2021.



- In Texas, only 2,400 new cases were reported on 03/20/2021.



- Positivity Rates: Texas 5.76% , Harris County- 10%, TMC- 5.3%
- TMC is reporting the ICU’s status to be back within Phase 1 capacity and was 98% full.
- Harris County Public Health data indicates West University to have 559 total “Confirmed Cases”, 13 “Active Cases”, 543 “Recovered Cases” and 0-5 “Deaths”. Harris County and City of Houston have merged their data bases and the number of deaths now shows a range of 0-5 but the math indicates a possible 3rd death due to COVID but this cannot be confirmed right now.
- Vaccine data indicates that 22% of Texans have received at least a first dose of vaccine and 11% have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19.
